The claim component entry user interface has been completely redesigned to enhance the user's experience. The changes manifest after saving the 3 Cs, the component entry screen automatically opens. Users can now enter multiple parts on the same page, eliminating numerous steps and shortening the submission process.

Please take note of the following:

- 1. Under the **Part #** (1) heading, click **+Add** to open a component line. Enter the component's part number, for brands with auto-populating part numbers, the price will populate automatically after entering the part number.
- 2. Under the Type (2) heading, choose the system type of the component by clicking the downward arrow to open the drop down menu.
- 3. Under the Code (3) heading, choose the sub-system of the component by clicking the downward arrow to open the drop down menu.
- 4. Under the Status (4) heading, users can indicate if a component will be denied. (Mostly used internally)
- 5. Under the Reason (5) heading, the reason for the denial would be indicated if a component is denied.
- 6. Under the **Cost Type (6)** heading, choose **Warranty cost**, **Dealer Cost**, or **Retail Cost** if applicable.
- 7. Under the **Unit Price** (7) heading, pricing will auto-populate for brands with that option. If not, it is an editable field, the component price can be entered here.
- 8. Under the QST/PST (8) heading is where taxes are shown. Each province has its own designation.
- 9. Under the Rate Type (9) heading, users can choose the type of labor needed, either Retail Standard, Warranty PPM, Warranty Standard, or Flat.
- 10. In case of a flat Rate (10), users can enter an mount in this field.
- 11. Under the Hours (11) heading, users can specify time units per repair.
- 12. In the event that the labor is sublet, users must check the box under the Sublet (12) heading.
- 13. The fields under the **Description** (13) heading are editable, branded contracts with auto-populating part numbers will include a short description of the component.
